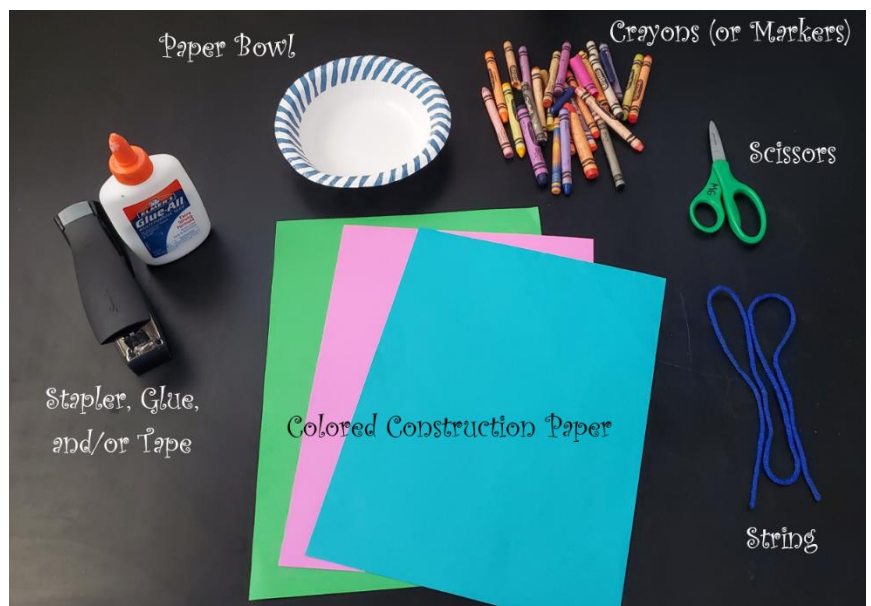


## Jellyfish!



### Materials You Will Need:

- ❖ Paper Bowl
- ❖ Colored Construction Paper
- ❖ Crayons, Markers, and/or Colored Pencils
- ❖ Scissors
- ❖ String
- ❖ Glue, Stapler, and/or Tape



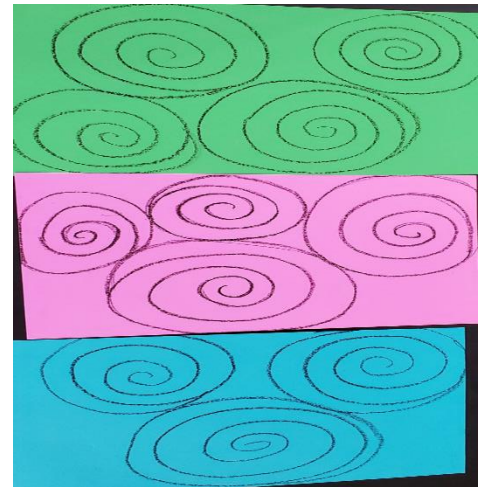
## Craft Instructions:

1. Flip the paper bowl upside down and color it in however you want. Get creative!
2. Once your jellyfish's bell (the bowl) is decorated, carefully use scissors to poke holes in the top and secure the string.



3. Draw different sized spirals on the construction paper. These will become your jellyfish's tentacles!

**Hint:** The tighter and bigger the spiral, the longer the tentacle will be!



4. Use the scissors to cut out the spirals that you've drawn on the construction paper. Ask an adult if you need help!




5. Your tentacles are now ready to be attached to the bell! Use glue, tape, or a stapler to secure the spirals to the bottom and sides of the bowl to create layers of flowing tentacles.



6. Flip your jellyfish right-side-up and voila, it's finished! It's fun to hang up in front of an open window to watch the tentacles move in the wind as if they were flowing in the ocean's currents!
